Career and Technical Education Alumni Hall of Fame

The purposes for the Career and Technical Education Alumni Hall of Fame are:

- A. To honor Career and Technical Education graduates who have obtained a leadership position in the occupational field in which they studied.
- B. To provide role models for students in Career and Technical Education.
- C. To make the public aware of successful Career and Technical Education graduates.

Alumni Qualifications

Candidates for nomination to the Career and Technical Education Alumni Hall of Fame must meet each of the following qualifications:

- ◇ Have graduated from the Career and Technical Education Program in any year from 1967 to the present.
- ◇ Demonstrate leadership in his/her field.
- ◇ Exercise civic responsibility.

Selection Procedures

- ◇ Career and Technical Education Instructors, Administrators, Board of Education Members, Advisory Council Members, Consultant Committee Members, and other interested parties can nominate one individual per year. A nomination form will be available through the Building Principals.
- ◇ All candidates will be informed of their nomination.
- ◇ The nominator will submit the completed application to the Director of Career and Technical Education by **April 24, 2009**.
- ◇ The nominations will be sent to the Career and Technical Education Advisory Council subcommittee, which will serve as the selection body.
- ◇ The Career and Technical Education Advisory Council may recommend one candidate each year from each campus to the Board of Cooperative Educational Services.
- ◇ Selection will be announced at the Award Ceremony held in June at each campus.
